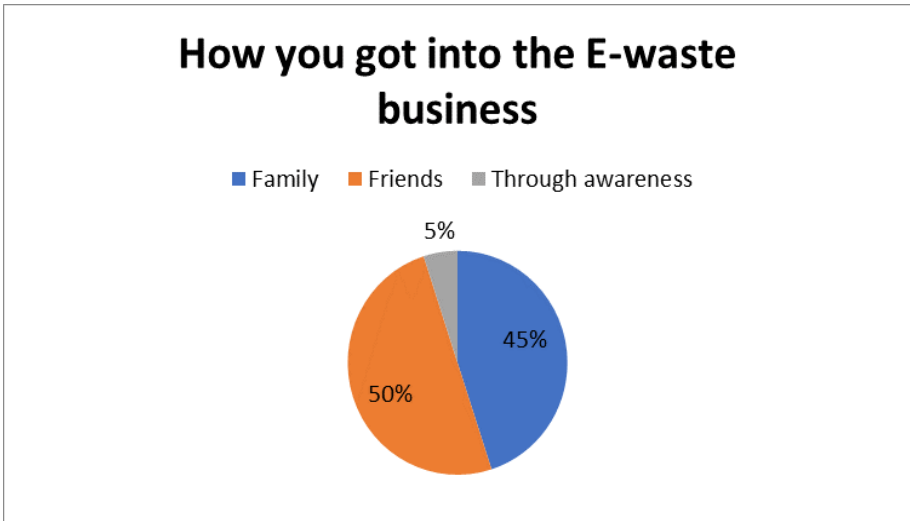
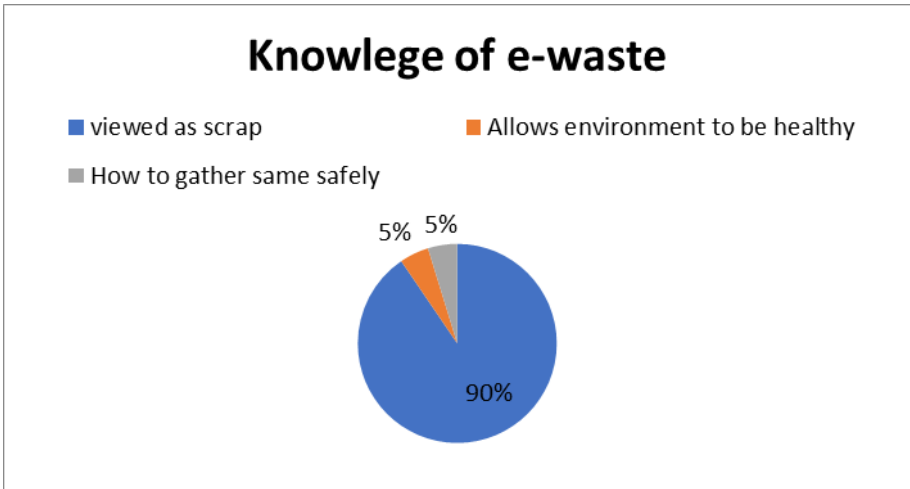
# Summary of 2018 Post Training Questionnaire Analysis

From our Questionnaire analysis it is imperative to note that most e-waste handlers in Lagos State has a good knowledge of E-waste and its effect to man and his environment. 90% of project beneficiaries recognized E-wastes as scraps. 50% of participants got into the scrap business through recommendation from friends, 45% from family while 5% were from awareness through the media.

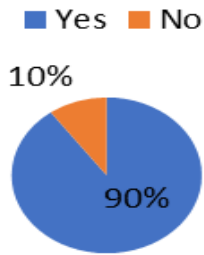
90% are aware of the effect of improper management and disposal of these E-waste. A lot of them appreciate the importance of the training while very few said it had little impact. As a result, 25% of them still apply lessons learnt to their daily activities. Knowledge gained from the training has made them more cautious and careful while handling Electronic waste in their facility. For them, E-waste is a very lucrative business.

From the Analysis 55% of participants suggested that for better engagement in the subsequent training the venue should be more assessible and close to their place of work while 25% recommended that the training should be done in their native language. Of the best ways to handle defaulters, 50% agreed that there should be regular training while 20% recommended easy access to better e-waste dismantling equipment and 5% asked for constant information on the dangers of these waste. The analysis shows that E-waste handling has had little or no health impact on them. 90% claimed to have no health challenge while 10% did.

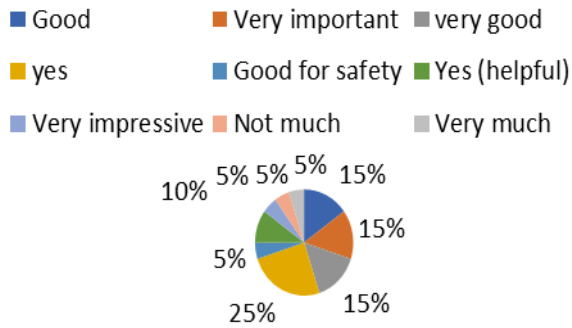

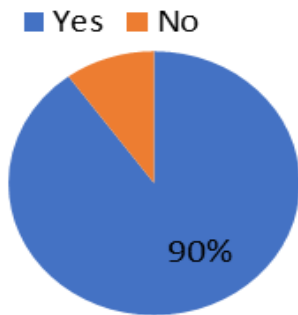
### Awareness of hazards due to poor disposal



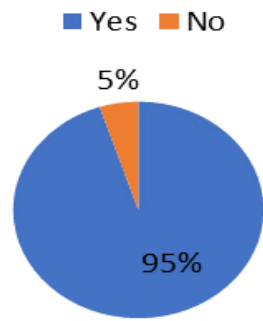
### Relevance of E-waste training to participants



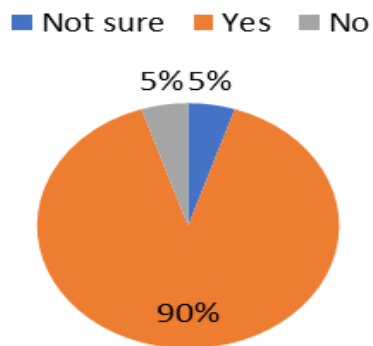
### application of lessons learnt to daily work

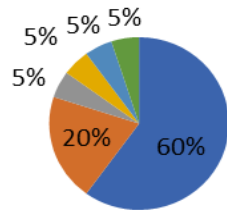

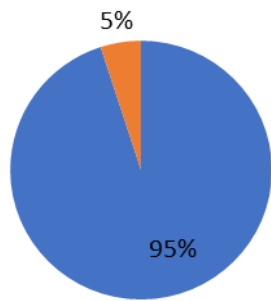
